Thanks to the support of our community partners, we are able to provide valuable assistance to seniors in need within the Prescott and Russell community.

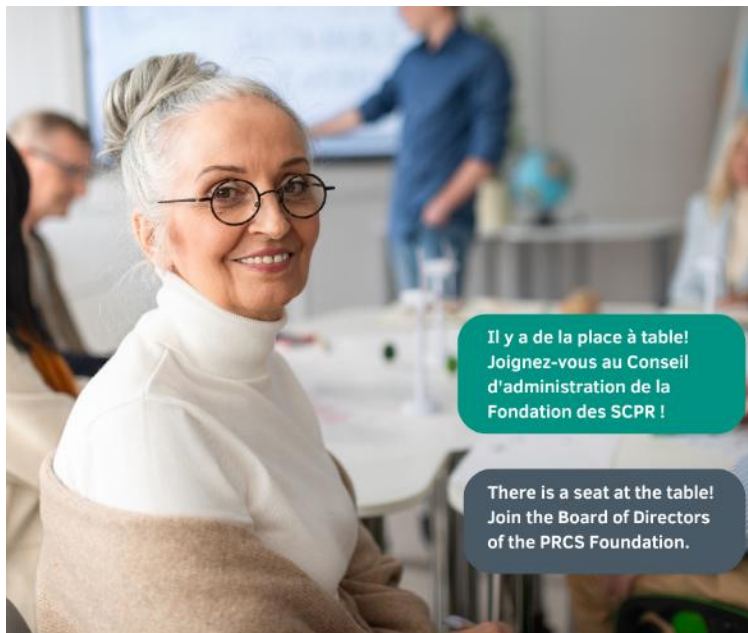
